The Meeting is open to the public, and this notice is provided under the Open Meetings Act 267 of 1976 as amended at MCL 15.263a for electronic public meetings.

No attendance is required to file a protest. Letter petitions on Form L-4035 received by The Board of Review before adjournment are acceptable.
