- SEWER** Advisory meeting was 2/6/23. DEQ reporting was completed and turned in. Next Wednesday well monitoring will be done. Al reported that he is still having problems with his plow after it being worked on at Classic. Prein & Newhoff to do an O&M manual. Fibertech back to doing the sewer's labs again, due to Eli retiring. Kate Cobb working with Michigan Works for an apprentice, lady she has been working with will come to a township meeting. Trustee Bradley has been working with Kevin Mannor from the Mannor Group on a life insurance policy for Al. He found one where we can do with only a group of one. We would have to become a member of SBAM (Small Business Association of Michigan) with a membership cost of \$129.00 annually. The policy would end when his employment ends with us. The only addition is the small monthly fee for a \$10,000.00 policy. **MOVED** by Bradley to accept the \$10,000.00 coverage for term life insurance policy and the \$129.00 annual membership with SBAM for Al, with the understanding that his policy will end upon termination of employment for any reason, aligning with the Township personnel manual. Supervisor Hall presented a proposal from Prein & Newhoff to update the O & M Manual and Sampling and Analysis Plan for Missaukee Sanitary Drain #2 for Discharge Permit Assistance. **MOTION** by Winkelmann to accept the proposed bid of up to \$8,000.00 for completion of work by Prein & Newhoff in order to update the O & M manual and create a Sampling and Analysis Plan for Missaukee Sanitary Drain #2 for Discharge Permit. Seconded by Ouwinga. **MOTION CARRIED.** Roll Call: Yes- Bradley, Hall, Ouwinga, Winkelmann. No-0. Absent- Woford.

Supervisor Hall talked with Mayor Ardis about developing a sewer authority between the City of Lake City and Lake Township. He also spoke with John Heinz out of Houghton Lake. Houghton Lake has 4 townships in one authority. The authority would make it easier to get loans for equipment replacement, easier on getting group insurance rates etc. In our case, the authority would handle both the city and the townships systems. City currently has 1300 users and the township has 800 users. City has their own vac truck, we had to previously rent Cadillac's. The
