Public Comments:	PUBLIC COMMENTS
Tony Fedewa- Questioned why there is two fire	
departments. Experienced less than satisfactory service	
from having two fire departments. Explained his	
experience from his home fire and having both	
departments show up. City is doing the right thing by	
joining the other dept, it's silly to have two and time to	
become one. Lake Township can't get along with other	
townships. Want to build a new fire department in Lake	
Township and that doesn't make sense. One department	
could have a lot better assets by all that equipment from	
both departments being in one barn. Need a sniffer	
because he wouldn't have had over \$100,000.00 of	
damage in his house. Describes the letter he received for	
his fire run- wasn't on letterhead, wasn't official and	
somewhere buried in the document he saw what he	
owed, he wasn't sure who to pay, it was less than	
professional. His insurance will only pay \$500.00 and	
that is reasonable for a fire run. Quit being children, we	
only need one fire barn. Doesn't know what he should tell	
his own children that grown adults can't get along. Looks	
silly that there's two departments. Creating less than an	
effective fire department for all of us. We have to figure	
out a way to make it work. Asked if Lake Township has	
less equipment now?	
Mimi Zwolak- Spoke up about Lake Township's attempt	
to try to merge with the other fire department and the	
option to buy their building. Theres so much baggage	
over the years & Station 200 stated that there is no way	
that they will join with Lake Township again. Agreed that	
it is ridiculous that there are two fire departments so	
close to one another. Her and Sam Ball sent a letter, had	

a meeting and the city didn't even show up. City is giving	
us three months in a new agreement and a month to	
month lease.	
Supervisor Hall- Explained the work that we have done	
up to this point regarding the fire department and what	
our options are moving forward. At the end of the month,	
we own all of the equipment, and the city is done. We	
have had an effective fire department for 13 years now	
without being at Station 200. Hall stated that he tried	
setting up an off-site meeting at a neutral location and no	
one was interested. The only communication he received	
was from Forest Township who stated that they were not	
interested. We received \$165,000.00 from the city for the	
money that they owed us that can go into adding on to	
the green road facility or a new facility.	
Gerard Winkle- Thanked the board for all we do.	
Questioned if there were other sites available for a fire	
barn other than Green rd. Has concerns for the residents	
in that subdivision. Offered to help in any way that he	
could for alternative sites within the township. Contacting	
Dutchman Tree Farms to see what options there may be	
for other locations. Gerard offered to meet with Trustee	
Norman and/or Supervisor Hall to discuss details. Also	
had concerns about hot patch fills that were poorly done	
in the Missaukee Park subdivision. Is that a county or	
township issue?	
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Unfinished Business-	
Attorney working on Solar Ordinance amendment	
for Wolverine Power.	
Tim Maylone- Discussed a lease agreement and	
or easement requested by Cherry Capital	
Communications for a fiber distribution center with	
a propane tank and a generator. Need the	
agreement signed so that Consumers can figure	
out the power path. Looking at a 20-year lease.	
Compensation would be free phone/internet to 4	
township locations. Supervisor Hall stated that he	
would have the township attorney look over the	
lease agreement. Maylone requested a letter of	
intent for the agreement to move forward.	
Township attorney to look over.
